




Reset

The following slides explain the username & password reset process.

Reset 1

If you have forgotten your eAdmissions username and/or password, these can easily be reset. To do this first click on the "Forgotten username or password?" link on the login screen.





If you know what your eAdmissions password is, you can click the "Login to eAdmissions" button otherwise click "Forgot Password"



Reset 5

You now need to choose how you would like to reset your password. The different options available to your account will be displayed on the screen.


In this example we will reset the password by email, and so will click on "By email" and then "Continue".
